1992 NCBTMB founded.

1996 NCBTMB begins the CE Provider Approval Program

1998 NC State Licensing begins

September 2005 First meeting of the FSMTB

December 2005 Dale Atkinson General Counsel, FSMTB Memo Re: Delegation of Authority for Competency Assessment

January 1, 2011- NCBTMB exams no longer accepted for licensure in NC. Exception made for out-of-state license endorsement.

March 2011- FSMTB forms a task force to re-evaluate CE requirements at the request of state boards

January 2012 FSMTB proposes the MOCC which met with much rejection

November 2012 NCBTMB released a new Approved Provider program to start January 2013- the commentary was such that the project went back to the drawing board.

Feb 2013 Rick Rosen proposed the National Continuing Education Registry

June 2013 NC State Board approved by motion a second request to the Federation of State Boards to set up a program to approve CE Providers.

October 2013 NCBTMB new (revised) approved provider program went into effect.

December 2013 Rick Rosen made a new proposal to the NC State Board regarding CE policy and approval in NC. Details are unknown.

February 2014 Rick Rosen releases his proposed model CE Regulations for State Boards.

February 2014 Nancy Weinberger submits rules change proposal to NC Board relating to CE.

February 2014 Coalition of Massage & Bodywork Educators meets.
